WHEREAS county government is composed of dedicated elected and appointed officials, as well as hard-working employees;


WHEREAS county government provides a voice to its local citizens, innovative solutions to community needs and problems, and cost-effective results that save local taxpayer money;

Passes and approved by the County Commissioners' Court of Tom Green County, Texas, on this the 28 day of ~~May~~ April, 2009.




