

175th Anniversary of the Texas Revolution
October 2, 2010 – April 21, 2011

The Tom Green County Historical Commission will commemorate the events and battles of the 1835 – 1836 Texas Revolution by flying the flags of each battle on the Courthouse Veterans Memorial flagpole on the appropriate days between October 2, 2010 and April 21, 2011. Special programs are also scheduled on selected dates and the location is noted below.

- * **October 2 - Battle of Gonzales** (Come and Take It flag) - 9:30 a.m. Courthouse Lawn Veterans Memorial
- * October 28 - Battle of Concepcion (Scott's Independence flag)
- * November 26 - The Grass Fight (Scott's Independence flag)
- * December 5 - 10 - Siege of Bexar (Scott's Independence flag, Brown's Bloody Arm flag)
- * December 20 - Goliad Declaration of Independence (Dimmitt's Goliad flag)
- * January 3 - Matamoros Expedition (1824 General Counsel naval flag)
- * January 8 - Battle of Velasco (Troutman's Lone Star flag)
- * February 23 - March 6 - Siege of the Alamo (Alabama Red Rovers, 1824)
- * March 1 - Washington on the Brazos - Constitutional Convention (Dodson's Lone Star flag)
- * March 10 - Brazoria - Six Masons meet at Masonic oak to petition for creation of the first Masonic Lodge in Texas
- * **March 2 - Texas Independence Day** (Dobson's flag)10:00 a.m. Courthouse Lawn Veterans Memorial and the Foyer of County Library
- * March 6 - Fall of the Alamo (1824 flag, Alabama Red Rovers flag)
- * March 8 - Siege of Goliad (Troutman's Lone Star, Alabama Red Rovers flags)
- * March 10 - Runaway Scrape begins (Baker's San Felipe flag)
- * March 11 - DeZavala's flag is adopted as official flag of Republic
- * March 27 - Goliad Massacre (Dimmitt's Goliad Flag)
- April 16 - Joint programs: San Jacinto Veterans Memorial and Confederate Memorial Day – Fairmount Cemetery
- * **April 21 - Battle of San Jacinto** (Flags of New Orleans Greys, Sidney Sherman, Baker's Red flag) - 4:00 p.m. Courthouse Lawn
