

Resolution Authorizing and Supporting Tom Green County 4-H Youth Shooting Range

Whereas, Tom Green County Commissioners Court supports the Texas AgriLife Extension Service and Tom Green County 4-H in their continuing efforts to develop youth and help them grow and learn life skills including responsibility, leadership and citizenship; and,

Whereas, Tom Green County maintains an existing relationship with Tom Green County 4-H; and,


Whereas, Tom Green County 4-H desires to fund, construct and maintain a Youth Shooting Range for the exclusive use of their organization to conduct trainings and competitions; and,

Whereas, Tom Green County owns real property that is conducive to the need, and is agreeable to Tom Green County 4-H utilization of the same for the purpose stated.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, TOM GREEN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT SHALL PROVIDE REAL PROPERTY FOR THE TOM GREEN COUNTY 4-H TO ESTABLISH A YOUTH SHOOTING FACILITY SUBJECT TO COMPLIANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS:

- The real property to be used for this facility shall be designated and identified by a metes and bounds description with a plat identifying the area in relationship to Tom Green County's other real property.
- A fence which shall secure the real property and facility and adequate ingress and egress shall be constructed and maintained around the designated property.
- Ensure the security of the property and facility which shall be the sole responsibility of Tom Green County 4-H.
- Property shall be maintained to a level for the designed purpose at all times.
- The initial agreement shall have a term of fifteen (15) years with an option for renewal subject to the sole discretion of the Commissioners Court of Tom Green County.
- The agreement may be terminated by either party in one hundred eighty (180) days after written notice has been delivered to lawful representatives of the parties.
- All maintenance, upkeep, utilities and associated operational costs shall be the sole responsibility of Tom Green County 4-H.
- Any and all construction will be in compliance with all rules, statutes and regulations as promulgated by the State, County and City where applicable.
- Nothing in this agreement shall commit Tom Green County to any financial obligation. Any expenditure must be specifically authorized by action of the Tom Green County Commissioners Court.
- All participants using property and facility who are not members of Tom Green County 4-H shall possess primary and non-participatory insurance coverage that indemnifies Tom Green County.
