Larry,

I am not sure what happened to the first email I sent the day we went and looked at the surplus shelving, I guess it ended up in Cyber space as I can not even find it on my email account.

The shelves we looked at and you put a note to hold for the Railway Museum were some white metal shelves by the front door about 8 foot and double with end cap the other was a single white metal wall unit also about eight feet long. The 3rd was on section about 4 foot wide by 8 foot tall with glass sliding doors near the back door we came in. The last was about a 12 foot section of the wood wall shelves on the south wall.

We need the shelving for the library we have established here at the museum. We currently have over 1400 magazines, 600 videos and 300 books dealing with the railroad and model railroading. and more being donated weekly. We also have been donated the largest collection of historic rail photos in the Us numbering more than 80,000 photos, negatives and slides. All of which we need shelving for.

Historic Orient/Santa Fe Depot, Inc. which runs the Railway Museum of San Angelo is a 501 c3 non-profit corporation.
