

**SUBMITTING AUTHORITY, STATUTORY AUTHORIZATION
FOR CHANGE, AND PROCEDURES UTILIZED FOR CHANGE**

The executive authority for Tom Green County is the Commissioners Court. This governmental body is a creature of the Texas Constitution (Article V, Section 18) composed of the County Judge, elected from the County as a whole, and four Commissioners, each elected from a geographic region of the County. The Commissioners Court is possessed of executive, judicial and legislative powers granted by the Texas Constitution, as enabled by Legislative enactment.
