

Post-implementation 120-day Collection Rate Review Tom Green County

The Office of Court Administration has completed a Post-Implementation Collection Rate (PICR) Review of the County's Court Collection Program. The objective of this review was to determine the 120-day collection rate of court costs, fees, and fines pursuant to Article 103.0033(f) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. The review covers the County's Fiscal Year 2012 (October 1, 2011 – September 30, 2012).

Please note: the PICR Review is not an audit and does not measure compliance with program requirements. The purpose of the review is to determine your 120-day collection rate since the implementation of your Court Collection Improvement Program and is for informational purposes only.

As a result of the review, the following information was determined:

120-day Collection Rate	73.63%
Collections - first 30 days	58.14%
Collections - days 31 - 60	7.26%
Collections - days 61 – 90	3.58%
Collections - days 91 – 120	4.64%

In addition, through the course of the review, the following information was obtained:

Percentage of jail time credit	4.80%
Percentage of community service credit	0.00%
Percentage of indigency waiver	0.00%
Total percentage of court costs, fees, and fines satisfied	78.42%
Percentage of people that paid immediately	39.01%
