

Joint Resolution and Memorandum of Agreement  
By and Between  
Tom Green County and Coke County, Texas

Coke and Tom Green County, Texas participate in the Concho Valley Council of Governments 911 Program; and

Coke County, Texas is terminating its agreement with the Robert Lee Care Center as its dispatch center known as Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP); and

Coke County, Texas desires to consolidate its 911 call volume with Tom Green County, Texas utilizing the Tom Green County Sheriff's Office as its PSAP. Tom Green County Sheriff's Office is a secondary PSAP for Tom Green County.

By this agreement, Coke County, Texas will route all its 911 calls to the Tom Green County Sheriff's Office. The Tom Green County Sheriff's Office will answer all 911 calls from Coke County, Texas and relay the emergency call information via (1) electronic device to appropriate EMS and ambulance staff for emergency medical services or appropriate Fire Departments and fire department staff for fire calls: (2) telephone call to Coke County Sheriff's Office for EMS, fire, public safety and traffic safety calls.

Coke County, Texas retains its addressing responsibilities for all residents of Coke County, Texas and will maintain and deliver to the Tom Green County Sheriff's Office a current addressing database.

The Coke County, Texas Exchange and Emergency Service Number (ESN 250-270 and 272-274) will appear on the dispatcher's screen at the Tom Green County Sheriff's Office.

Any Standard Operating Procedures will be agreed upon by the Coke County Sheriff and the Tom Green County Sheriff.

Coke County, Texas will hold harmless Tom Green County, Texas for failure to transfer calls except for negligence.

Coke County, Texas will pay the sum of \$21,000 per year to Tom Green County, Texas for this service payable \$5250 quarterly or \$21,000 annually.

This agreement is binding on and for the benefit of the parties and their successors.

This agreement is effective upon execution of all parties and continues from year to year until terminated. Either party may terminate by giving 60 days written notice to the other.

## Standard Operating Procedure

Between

Tom Green County

And

Coke County Sheriff's Office, Bronte VFD, RL VFD, Bronte EMS, and RL EMS

By this agreement, Coke County, Texas will route all 911 calls to the Tom Green County Sheriff's Office dispatch. Tom Green County Sheriff's Office will answer all 911 calls from Coke County, Texas twenty-four hours a day, 7 days a week. Tom Green County will relay the emergency call information via (1) setting off the appropriate tones via radio for the Bronte VFD and Robert Lee VFD as well as Bronte Volunteer EMS and Robert Lee Volunteer EMS service. (2) Tom Green County will contact the Coke County Sheriff's Office Dispatch via telephone (453-2717) for Public Safety and traffic safety calls, as well as Fire and EMS calls.
