

EXHIBIT B COMPENSATION

ADDENDUM

In consideration for the services provided in connection with this Agreement, the County shall pay Clinic as follows:

1. For Nurse Practitioner Services-a monthly payment of Two Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$2,500).
2. For Nursing Services-a monthly payment of Fifty Six Thousand Four Twenty Five and no/100 Dollars (\$56A25).

The costs are due to the additional staffing required to provide extended hours and services to the Tom Green County Jail.

1. One additional RN to provide coverage Monday-Friday 2-10 PM
 - a. RN will assist RN Manager with booking assessments, follow up TB administration coordination and reporting TAC §273.7, gather and review medical records for medical review with the provider, assist with sick call and triaging inmates
 - b. Texas Board of Nursing recommends that only RN(s) complete "triage assessments" in any setting.
 - c. Assist RN Manager with ensuring Health Service Plans are current, in place, and monitored
 - d. RN to help RN Manager ensure health records meet TAC Rule §273.4
 - e. Aid and assist with restraint reviews TAC §273.6
 - f. RN will be back up support for RN Manager Stephanie Sherwood
 - g. Decrease overtime accumulated by RN Manager
2. One additional CMA for each shift (for a total of 3) Monday-Sunday to administer medications. This will also cover the increase in shifts from 10am-6pm to 6am-2pm and 2pm-10pm Saturday and Sunday.
 - a. This will allow nursing staff to provide medication administration services without disruption, decrease medication variances, increase quality of care; and provide quicker medical interventions by having a LVN assigned to working medicals

requested by inmates, assist with booking assessments, and TB administration and reporting (tied to TAC §273.21, §273.22, §273.23, §273.24, §273.210)

- Increase medical assessments by nursing staff on the weekends
 - Improve quality and delivery of care
 - Decrease liability
 - Decrease grievances by inmates
- b. Eliminate the use of non-clinical staff for medication administration
- This would help with TAC §273.26 (the control, distribution, secured storage, inventory)
 - Medications may be administered only by physicians, licensed nursing personnel, permitted medication aides, or persons who are exempt from licensure or permit requirements pursuant to the Health and Safety Code, §242.1511.

3. Nurse Practitioner Services.

- a. Nurse practitioner services have increased at an average of 100% (from 4 hours to 8 hours) in order to meet all clinical demands of the jail.
- b. There will be no increase to the cost of the Nurse Practitioner service as a good faith effort to Tom Green County Jail.
