A RESOLUTION OF TOM GREEN COUNTY, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE LIVE OAK CREEK COLONIA AS AN OFFICAL COLONIA AREA FOR INCLUSION IN THE TEXAS SECRETARY OF STATE'S DIRECTORY OF COLONIAS.


WHEREAS, Tom Green County completed a colonia comprehensive plan in 2004 that identified most colonias within the county that meet the federal Cranston-Gonzales National Affordable Housing Act requirements used by the Community Development Block Grant program; and,

WHEREAS, the County recognizes that residents of such areas also lack the basic infrastructure to ensure a decent quality of life such as access to potable water, proper wastewater disposal, safe and sanitary housing, and adequate access to and safety from flooding;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TOM GREEN COUNTY, TEXAS:

- Section 1. That the Live Oak Creek colonia located along Highway 87 has been identified as meeting the federal colonia criteria used by the Community Development Block Grant program.
- Section 2. That the Live Oak Creek colonia shall be income surveyed and mapped to verify certain other eligibility characteristics for possible grant applications for assistance.
- Section 3. That the information necessary to request that the Live Oak Creek Colonia be added to the Texas Directory of Colonias maintained by the Secretary of State shall be forwarded to such agency in all due haste.


