**WHEREAS**, the Tom Green County prepared a master plan for the historic courthouse as part of the requirements for participation in the Texas Historical Commission's Texas Historic Courthouse Preservation Program; and

**WHEREAS**, Tom Green County approved the master plan for use in the ongoing preservation of the courthouse; and

**WHEREAS**, Tom Green County successfully applied for and utilized Texas Historical Commission grant assistance in the past; and


**WHEREAS**, the courthouse is in need of critical additional repairs;


