**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS AND COUNTY OF TOM GREEN, TEXAS**

**2015 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD  
LOCAL SOLICITATION**

This Agreement is made and entered into this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2015, by and between The COUNTY of TOM GREEN, acting by and through its governing body, the Commissioners Court, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and the CITY of SAN ANGELO, acting by and through its governing body, the City Council, hereinafter referred to as "CITY", both of TOM GREEN County, State of TEXAS, witnesseth:

**WHEREAS**, this Agreement is made under the authority of Chapter 791 of the Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party; and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, CITY agrees to provide COUNTY \$5,691.00 from the JAG award for Technology Improvement Program; and

**WHEREAS**, CITY and COUNTY believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds.

**NOW THEREFORE, CITY and COUNTY agree as follows:**

**Section 1.**

CITY agrees to pay COUNTY a total of \$5,691.00 of JAG funds.

**Section 2.**

COUNTY agrees to use \$5,691.00 for the Technology Improvement Program until September 30, 2016.

**Section 3.**

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Texas Tort Claims Act.

**Section 4.**

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Texas Tort Claims Act.

**Section 5.**

Each party to this Agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this Agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

**Section 6.**

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

**Section 7.**



The following information concerns the goal of the requested money from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant.

Purchase Goal - Tom Green County Sheriff's Office: The goal of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant for the Tom Green County Sheriff's Office is to obtain an Alternative Light Source Kit and a handheld Forward Looking Infrared Imaging system (FLIR).

The FAL3000 is a complete kit including all of the equipment needed for an intense, thorough search for evidence at a crime scene. The FAL3000 Forensic Alternative Light Source simplifies locating items of forensic interest. The compact, self-contained light source offers unlimited freedom to move about the crime scene. The instrument may be hand-held or mounted on a standard photographic-type tripod. Battery operation permits searching a multitude of surfaces and especially when searching for micro particle, physiological or latent print evidence.

The EOTech X320 is a small, lightweight, and concealable thermal imager. The EOTech X320 is used for surveillance and reconnaissance in law enforcement activities. The X320 offers advanced 320 x 240 pixel performance in the palm of the hand. It can be easily stored in a pocket and detects human activity out to 800 yards. Thermal imagers are ideal for spotting targets because they detect heat against an otherwise cooler background. They can be used during the day or night and can see through light smoke, fog, rain, snow, and other atmospheric conditions.

The price of the Alternative Light Source Kit is \$3,995.00 and the price for the FLIR is \$3,500.00. Total amount for both items is \$7495.00; \$5691.00 will be paid by grant funding. The remaining \$1,804.00 will come from the Sheriff's Office's regular operating budget.

At this time the Tom Green County Sheriff's Office does not have the extra/required funds in the regular budget to purchase the Alternative Light Source Kit and the Forward Looking Infrared Imaging system (FLIR) therefore; JAG Grant Funds will be utilized to supplement the funds in the Sheriff's Office annual operating budget to purchase these items.
