Many of you are also progressing toward completion of the Commissioners Court Advanced Curriculum (CCAC) Program, a voluntary, 64-credit course of advanced training in county government. Your CCAC transcript is also attached and reflects CCAC courses attended through the end of 2015*. Courses in Phase II and III are offered annually at the V.G. Phase I may only be earned by attending the LBJ School seminar: Governing Texas Counties for Newly Elected Officials, and the next opportunity will be 2017. If you participate in the CCAC program, you must meet the requirements of the program to earn the certificate of completion, as follows: 16 credits in Phase I, 16 credits in Phase II, and 32 credits in Phase III, totaling 64 credits.


