REGARDING AUXILIARY FACILITIES FOR DISTRICT COURTROOM


Because of the continuing need for additional court space whenever more than one trial is being held at the same time, the Commissioners Court of Tom Green County, Texas does hereby resolve as follows:

Whenever in the opinion of the 340th District Judge, there is a necessity to hold court outside of the Tom Green County Courthouse or the Tom Green County Justice Center, the 340th Judicial District Court of Tom Green County, Texas may utilize the Southland Baptist Church Family Life Center as a designated auxiliary facility.



