

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TOM GREEN COUNTY, TEXAS  
ACKNOWLEDGING THE IMMEDIATE NEED OF UTILITY-SCALE SOLAR POWER  
GENERATION FACILITIES TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN TOM GREEN COUNTY, TEXAS**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tom Green County has been presented information concerning the proposed construction of a Utility-Scale Solar Power Generation and Storage Project in Tom Green County, Texas, and

**WHEREAS**, Tom Green County and San Angelo in particular, currently is home to utility-scale renewable power generation facilities and has demonstrated abilities to work successfully with large utility-scale renewable energy projects, and

**WHEREAS**, this type of utility-scale renewable solar power generation plant will provide funding in the form of property taxes to Tom Green County, and will benefit power consumers throughout the State of Texas. This type of utility-scale renewable power generation facility is important to the quality of life of citizens in Tom Green County and the State of Texas, and it is essential that these kinds of opportunities are developed to provide such services to the citizens of Tom Green County, San Angelo, and the State of Texas,


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED** by the Commissioners Court of Tom Green County, Texas that:



Section 4: This resolution shall be in effect as of the date of its approval.






