**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved**, that the Commissioner's Court of Tom Green County approves submission of grant application for the Tom Green County Constable's Office Equipment Project to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.

Duly adopted at a meeting of the Tom Green County Commissioner's Court this 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2019.




